This year we are planning a “new” event designed specifically for high school choral students and their directors.

On **January 18-19, 2008** we would like to invite you and your outstanding high school choral students (9-12) to be our guests on campus for our ***1st Annual Southeastern United States Honor Choir Festival***. Guest conductor for the Honor Choir will be Dr. Tom Wine, Director of Choirs at Wichita State University (KS).

Highlights of the festival will include:

- **100 voice high school Honor Choir rehearsals with Dr. Wine accompanied by School of Music faculty member Dr. Hui-Ting Yang**
- **Sectionals/Master classes with School of Music faculty including Dr. Michael Hix, Dr. Catherine Allard, Dr. Meg Jackson, and Dr. Diane Orlofsky**
- **Special host Friday night showcase concert**
- **Finale Concert by the Festival Honor Choir on Saturday afternoon**

Festival registration will begin at 9:00 A.M. on Friday January 18th in the lobby of Crosby Theater, with rehearsals beginning at 10:00 A.M. Students will have an opportunity to audition for scholarships during the festival. The Finale Concert on Saturday January 19th will begin at 3:00 P.M.

Students will be selected to perform in the Honor Choir based on director recommendations. There is a \$20.00 registration fee per student which includes a festival T-shirt, professionally recorded CD of the Honor Choir performance, and an Honor Choir festival student performance certificate. Participating Choir Director T-shirts and CD's are free!

Please complete the **Honor Choir Festival Director Recommendation Form** and return it to us no later than **November 1st, 2007**. Directors and students will be notified of student acceptance by **November 15th**. Student registration fees for students selected to participate will be due by **December 1st, 2007**.
